(1) The impugned order has been passed by DRT-III, Chandigarh dismissing the SA filed by the petitioners, unfortunately even without calling the Bank and have its viewpoint on the petitioners' allegations.

(2) Be that as it may, the said order is appealable before the Debt Recovery Appellate Tribunal.

(3) The instant writ petition is thus disposed of relegating the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy. The Appellate Tribunal is requested to take up the *ad interim* stay matter at the earliest as the petitioners are stated to be in possession of the residential house. With a view to enable the petitioners to approach the Appellate Tribunal, *status quo re*: residential house shall be maintained for a period of one month.
