The petitioner seeks regularization of service from the date his alleged junior Raj Kumar was regularized w.e.f. 1.4.2011. Both of them were appointed as Part Time Sweepers. The petitioner has served a legal notice dated 5.1.2008 (Annex.P-6) on the authorities which has not been decided. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the competent authority amongst the respondents to decide the legal notice within a fixed time frame.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the legal notice (Annex. P-6) within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Needless to say if the benefit is to be declined, reasoned order will be passed and the same will be conveyed to the petitioner.
