In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court dated 21.09.2015 (Annexure P-4).

2. Perusal of the record, it is evident that management have expressed their readiness to take back the petitioner to duty. Petitioner-workman has not shown his interest to report back to duty which is evident from para-11 of the award passed by the Labour Court. In the absence of necessary material to show that petitioner has shown his interest to work with the management, petitioner's contention cannot be accepted to the extent that he has shown his interest to work with the management.

3. Accordingly, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the award passed by the Labour Court dated 21.09.2015.

4. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
