S.J.VAZIFDAR, CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL)

In our view, considering the nature of the disputes, the petitioner ought to avail the alternative remedy of an appeal under Section 129-A of the Customs Act, 1962. The impugned order itself mentions that the appeal is maintainable. Regulation 21 of the Customs Brokers Licencing Regulation Authority 2013 prima facie indicates that the appeal against the impugned order is maintainable.

The petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioner to the alternative remedy of an appeal. It is, however, clarified that in the event of the appeal is not being held to be maintainable for any reason, this petition shall revive without further orders. The issue as to where the appeal is to be filed is kept open. Any application for early hearing shall be made before the Appellate Authority.
