The petitioners were appointed as Part-time Sweepers between 06.07.1998 to 20.08.1998. Their services were regularized w.e.f. 14.05.2013. The limited grievance that they have is; that the respondents had regularized the services of many of those employees, who were identically placed as petitioners, w.e.f. 01.04.2011. Therefore, the services of the petitioners too ought to have been regularized from the same date. The petitioners purport to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the legal notice dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure P-4), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, as also the legal notice dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure P-4), within a period of three months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. And, pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
