In the present writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour court dated 08.09.2017 (Annexure P-11). Respondent-workman services have been engaged under particular scheme vide Annexure P2 dated 07.09.2007. There were allegations against respondent No.2-workman in respect of discharging the duties. Therefore, Gram Panchayat proceeded to pass a resolution in removing services of respondent No.2-workman. When the employee is removed on the allegations minimum requirement is to hold inquiry. Perusal of the finding recorded by the Labour court at para 12 it is crystal clear that no inquiry has been held. Consequently, petitioner has not made out a case to interfere with the award passed by the Labour court dated 08.09.2017.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
