The respondent-husband had been granted decree of divorce dated 11.09.2015. Aggrieved by the said order, the appellant-wife has preferred the present appeal.

During pendency of the appeal, the parties have entered into a compromise Exhibit CX which bears signature of both the parties. Counsel for both the parties admit that Exhibit CX has been signed by the parties voluntarily.

As per the terms of settlement besides settling issue regarding custody of the minor child, the arrangement has been made for permanent alimony to be paid by the respondent-husband to the appellant-wife.

Baldev Singh, present in the Court, has got possession of two demand drafts of Rs.12 lacs and Rs. 6 lacs as per the terms of compromise Exhibit CX.

The appeal is disposed of as withdrawn.

Application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act is also disposed of.

Let the amount be handed over to appellant-wife Kiranjeet Kaur in the Court on 03.04.2018.
