Counsel for the parties have agreed that the amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- agreed to be paid by the insurance company in terms of the compromise shall be deposited with the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Rupnagar within a period of five weeks and the same shall be released in favour of claimant No. 2, mother of the deceased, on the basis of application to be filed by her before the Tribunal.
