By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the DCRG accrued to him on account of his retirement.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner stood retired on October 31, 2016 as Superintending Engineer but till date the amount accrued to the petitioner on account of DCRG has not been released/dispensed to him despite the fact that it stands sanctioned vide letter dated November 03, 2016.

3. Keeping in view the fact that the amount accrued to the petitioner on account of DCRG has already been sanctioned by the concerned authority but it has not been paid, notice to the petition is dispensed with at this stage and instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to make the

payment of DCRG accrued to the petitioner in terms of letter dated November 03, 2016 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order that too, along-with interest @9% per annum on the delayed payment of DCRG after the expiry of three months period from the date of retirement of petitioner.

4. In case of non-compliance of afore-said direction petitioner is at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under law including to approach this Court.
