The petitioner prays for a direction to the respondent-authorities to fix his pay at par with his junior i.e. respondent No.5, by awarding the necessary step up along with all consequential benefits. He purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even, the legal notice dated 27.09.2016 (Annexure P7), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to consider and decide the claim/grievance of the petitioner, as also the legal notice dated 27.09.2016 (Annexure P7), within a period of 3 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Needless to assert, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
