Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix/revise his pay and pension in accordance with law after granting him the grade pay of Rs.5200 w.e.f. 01.02.2012 as admissible to Junior Engineers after completion of 18 years of service under Assured Career Progression Rules of respondents issued vide order no.872 dated 27.02.2009 (P-3) WITH FURTHER to grant the arrears and all consequential benefits arising thereto along with interest @ 18% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representations dated 29.10.2015 & 26.02.2018 (P-4 & P-5) were made to the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said representations has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned Department. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is

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issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 26.02.2018 (P-5) within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents particularly respondent No.2- Superintending Engineer/Admin II, Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited, Shakti Bhawan, Sector 6, Panchkula (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 26.02.2018 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
