Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral dues including gratuity, leave encashment, commutation of pension benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum as well as interest on delayed payment of GPF WITH FURTHER to release the entire arrears of salary to him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations/legal notices including latest legal notice dated 29.01.2018 (P-4) were made to the respondents but till date no action has been taken by the concerned Department. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 29.01.2018 (P-4) within stipulated period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 29.01.2018 (P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
