In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No. 3 to deposit cheque or demand draft for ₹ 40,000/- in the name of appellant-Anish @ Aleem with the Office of Lok Adalat of the High Court within six weeks from today and the same be handed over to the appellant against proper receipt and identification, failing which, the amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of settlement till its realization.
