The petitioner has filed present civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of the letter/notice dated 01.01.2018 (Annexure P-5), letter dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-7) and letter dated 22.03.2018 (Annexure P-8), whereby the petitioner was asked to submit his clarification, otherwise the proceedings would be initiated against him.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he has misappropriated the Gram Panchayat soil and has sold the soil from the land (Hadarori) of the village after excavation. The petitioner is stated to have submitted a clarification including the clarification (Annexure P-9). Admittedly, this clarification has been submitted only on 04.04.2018. Therefore, it can safely be presumed that the same must be under consideration of the authorities. Thus, this Court finds that the present petition

without awaiting a decision on clarification dated 04.04.2018 is nothing but a pre-mature one.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as pre-mature. However, the respondent No.2 shall take a decision on the clarification dated 04.04.2018 (Annexure P-9) so submitted by the petitioner within a prescribed period of two months from today.
