The petitioners have filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking direction to the respondents to protect their Fundamental right for Trade and Commerce as enshrined in Articles 19(1)(g)[1] and 301 of the Constitution of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the grievance in the present writ petition, the petitioners have already submitted a representation (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar on 09.04.2018.

Considering the fact that the representation (Annexure P-3) has been made on 09.04.2018 and the present writ petition has been filed on 10.04.2018, this Court finds that the petitioners have shown unnecessary haste in approaching the Court through the instant writ petition.

Therefore, the present writ petition is dismissed as the petitioners have not waited for the outcome of the representation dated 09.04.2018 (Annexure P-3).
