The respondent-Mandeep Kaur had been granted the decree of divorce under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, vide impugned judgment and decree dated 27.11.2015 passed by Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur. Appeal has been filed by the appellant against the said decree of divorce.

During the pendency of the appeal, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement signed by both of them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of Punjab and Haryana High Court, which is taken on record as Ex.C1. As per the said settlement, the parties have decided to part company, subject to the conditions mentioned in the Settlement/Agreement dated 1.6.2018.

Counsel for both the parties submit that in view of the terms of settlement, the appeal may be dismissed as having infructuous, making the parties bound by the terms of Ex.C1, which is made part of the record.

Ordered accordingly.

The appeal stands dismissed in the above said terms.
