MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral)

We have heard the parties. The petitioner's case is that he was kept away from the process of counselling on account of the fault of the State as his result was not declared in time. This is refuted by the learned counsel for the respondent-State, who has stated that the result of NEET was declared on 23.01.2018 and the web-portal of the State qua admission for graduate courses remained open from 09.03.2018 to 24.03.2018 but the petitioner did not apply despite the fact that his result was declared on 24.03.2018. In any eventuality, it is stated that the web-portal is to be opened once again from 03.05.2018 to 16.05.2018 and the petitioner if so chooses to apply, his case would be considered.

Since it is a time bound admission and we cannot put the clock back, no purpose would be served by giving any direction to the State, particularly when the web-portal is likely to be opened from 03.05.2018 to 16.05.2018 when the petitioner would have another opportunity to apply.

Petition stands dismissed.
