1. The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.1 to 3 to restrain the authorized dealers of motorcycle/scooter companies from selling the motorcycles/scooters to any customer, purchaser (including sub-dealers) without getting the said vehicles registered either with temporary number and also to stop the authorized dealers to sell the motorcycles/scooters to any customer, purchaser (including sub-dealers) without getting the vehicles insured as it violates the mandatory provisions of 'The Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989'.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since certain relevant facts and material to substantiate the averments made in the writ petition could not be incorporated, therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
