Aggrieved by the dismissal of his petition for declaring the marriage void with the respondent, the appellant-husband has preferred this appeal.

The appellant had been directed to pay a sum of Rs.25,000/- towards the interim litigation expenses to the respondent-wife vide order dated 01.02.2018. Parties were also directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to arrive at some amicable settlement.

Proxy counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. Narinder Kumar Vadhera, Advocate informs that despite efforts having been made by the Advocate, the appellant could not be contacted.

Perusal of the mediation proceedings indicate that the appellant had not put in appearance before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre also despite a direction passed by this Court.

In view of said circumstances, the appeal is dismissed for non-compliance of the order passed by this Court with liberty to the appellant to

seek the revival of the appeal along with a bank draft of Rs.25,000/- in the name of the respondent-wife, within a period of one month.
