An application for condoning the statutory period of six months under Section 13-B(2) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed after recording of the statements of the parties at first motion stage alongwith an application for preponing the matter.

Both the parties are present. They have made a joint statement today.

We have considered the statement made by both the parties today. In the light of parameters laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Amardeep Singh Vs Harveen Kaur, 2017(4) R.C.R. (Civil), 608, we record a satisfaction that in view of the statements made by both the parties, the statutory period under law being already over on account of prolonged separation, all efforts of mediation having already been undertaken and all issues of alimony having settled, it will be in the interest of both the parties

to waive off the statutory period under Section 13-B (2) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 to curtail the prolonged agony and to enable the parties to resettle in life. Both the miscellaneous applications are allowed. The date of hearing in the main appeal is preponed from 10.8.2018 to today and is taken up for hearing. The petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is allowed. The marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent. Parties will be bound by the terms of settlement Ex.CX.
