The present petition has been filed for directions to respondents to issue no objection certificate to the petitioner to display advertisement through unipole at Delta Square, 5th Floor, MG Road, Sector 25, IFFCO Chowk, Gurugram.

Respondent No.1 is Municipal Corporation, Gurugram and respondent No.2 Joint Commissioner-IV, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram.

The petitioner filed an online application seeking permission of respondent No.1 for display of Outdoor Media Devices (OMD) through Unipole at the aforesaid site.

Respondent No.1 issued Letter of Intent (LOI) dated 16.02.2018.

As per the LOI issued, the petitioner was required to deposit

₹24,07,680/- within seven days through a demand draft in favour of the

Commissioner Municipal Corporation, Gurugram or via online payment.

In the petition, it was alleged that petitioner made payment of the said amount. The grievance of the petitioner was that inspite of fulfilling all the conditions he was not issued no-objection certificate.

Notice of motion was issued vide order dated 18.04.2018.

Learned Counsel for respondent No. 1 contends that the LOI granted to the petitioner has already been withdrawn on 09.05.2018. There is no question of issuance of no objection certificate. Copy of the order withdrawing the LOI has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the withdrawal of LOI, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Needless to add, if petitioner, has any grievance against the order dated 09.05.2018 it would be at liberty to have remedies against the said order.
