In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Pump
Operator Grade-II, in response to the advertisement dated 30.12.2016
(Annexure P-2), in ESM(General)/Ex-servicemen self Category. He
qualified the written examination by scoring 110 marks, and thereafter, his
documents were also duly scrutinised. He participated in the interview, but
in the final results pronounced by the Commission, his status was depicted:
'rejected'. It is urged that the petitioner has repeatedly represented to the
respondents, post pronouncement of the results, to ascertain the reason for
which his candidature was rejected/ignored. But to no avail. He submits

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that although the process of selection has since been concluded, but the appointments have not yet been made.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents, within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner as also to his counsel..

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim/grievance of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
