By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to reconsider his case for revision of pension under Rule 9.15 of Punjab Civil Services Rules, considering services rendered by him as work charge employee since 15.12.1979 as RTM (Regular Team Mate) w.e.f. 31.01.2010 along with interest WITH FURTHER to decide the writ of demand dated 23.02.2018 within a stipulated period.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations including writ of demand dated 23.02.2018 (P-8) were issued to the respondents but till date no response has been received by them. He feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid writ of demand, within some specified period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Chief Engineer (P&M), Punjab State Transmission Corporation Ltd., Ludhiana, Punjab to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the writ of demand dated 23.02.2018 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and regulations issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
