This appeal has arisen from the order dated 20.10.2016 passed by the Additional District Judge, Kurukshetra by which the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) by the respondent-husband has been allowed and the marriage of the petitioner with the respondent was dissolved by a decree of divorce.

During the pendency of this appeal, the parties have entered into a compromise/agreement which has been recorded in writing on 31.08.2018.

As per the compromise, respondent-husband has paid a sum of ₹12,50,000/- by way of draft to the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant has thus submitted that this appeal may be disposed in terms of the Panchayati compromise/agreement dated 31.08.2018.

Hence, this appeal is hereby disposed of, in view of the terms and conditions of the Panchayati compromise/agreement dated 31.08.2018 and the decree of divorce, awarded in favour of the respondent-husband on 20.10.2016 by the trial Court shall be maintained.
