This appeal has arisen from the judgment and decree dated 27.01.2016 passed by the Additional District Judge, Kaithal by which petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 [for short 'the Act'] by the respondent-husband for dissolution of his marriage by way of a decree of divorce was allowed.

During the pendency of this appeal, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court where the parties had settled their dispute and reduced the same into writing by way of a settlement/agreement dated 30.4.2018. Thereafter, the parties are living together again as husband and wife without there being any friction. Today, the respondent-husband is present in-person in Court. He is identified by Hitesh Kumar, who is further identified by Mr.Samir Rathore, Advocate as the brother of the appellant/wife. It is submitted that since the parties are no more at loggerhead therefore, the present appeal may be disposed of as having rendered infructuous and the respondent-husband may also be

allowed to withdraw the petition filed under Section 13 of the Act before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances and also the happy ending, we are of the considered opinion that it would be just and expedient, if permission is granted to the respondent-husband to withdraw the petition filed under Section 13 of the Act though the same has been allowed by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present appeal is hereby disposed of as having rendered infructuous after the petition filed under Section 13 of the Act filed by the respondent-husband has been withdrawn.
