This petition is filed for extension in the period of parole, which was granted to the petitioner for a period of 6 weeks starting from 25.02.2018. The benefit of parole granted to the petitioner is coming to an end on 20.04.2018 as the petitioner has to submit himself to the Jail Authorities by 5.00 p.m. on that date.

The prayer for extension of parole has been made by the petitioner only on the ground that he has to make arrangements for the residence of his family.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, examining the available record and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances much-less the reason assigned in the application for seeking extension in parole, I am of the considered opinion that there is hardly any reason to interfere in this petition and hence, the same is hereby dismissed, though without any order as to costs.
