Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the pensionary and other benefits as well as ACP, on the basis of final seniority list i.e. considering the date of promotion as Principal to be 15.02.2010 and not 08.05.2012 with further direction to decide the representation dated 07.09.2017 (P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated 07.09.2017 (P-6) was duly served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent

No. 2 to decide the afore-said legal notice in a time bound manner.

3. In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 07.09.2017 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations as well as instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law including to approach this Court.
