This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3 whereby Government Elementary School, Paharpur Kalan has been allotted to Manjit Singh/Respondent No.6 while ignoring the seniority of the petitioner.

The sole grouse of the petitioner is that despite being senior to respondent No.6, the petitioner has been denied posting at Paharpur Kalan, Bhadson-I, District Patiala.

Heard.

From the perusal of the case file, it emerges that the station in question was originally allotted to respondent No.5 who is senior to the petitioner. However, a request was received through Block Elementary Education Officer for inter-changing the allotted stations of respondent

Nos.5 and 6 with mutual consent. The request having been received through the proper forum was entertained at the spot and therefore, station in question was allotted to respondent No.6 though, junior to the petitioner.

In the meantime, the petitioner had also withdrawn her request for allotment of the said station. Therefore, this Court does not find any illegality or perversity in the impugned action of the respondents in allotting respondent No.6 the station in question.

Thus, in view of the discussion, the present writ petition sans merit, stands dismissed.
