In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is employed as Assistant Secretary in the office
of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Palwal. He was placed under
suspension, pursuant to an order dated 12.1.2018 (Annexure P-2), passed by
Joint Transport Commissioner (RS), Haryana. Vide order dated 29.1.2018
(Annexure P-4), issued by respondent No.2, the order of his suspension was
confirmed. It is urged that the appeal preferred by the petitioner, against his
suspension, is pending consideration before respondent No.1, and continues
to await a decision thereupon.

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In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents, and if, indeed, any such appeal, as indicated above, is pending, the same shall be disposed of, within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
