In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner prays for a writ in the nature of Mandamus,
directing the respondents to consider his claim for promotion to the post of
Assistant Sub Inspector, from the date his juniors were promoted, with all
consequential benefits. It is urged that the suitability/entitlement of the
petitioner to be considered for promotion, is not in dispute, and rather, the
matter is under active consideration of the respondent authorities for quite
some time. But the only grievance that he has is; that a final decision
thereupon has not been reached.

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In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents, within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
