This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of the respondents whereby the petitioners have been deprived of their seniority.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Director General of Police, Intelligence, Punjab, Sector-77, Mohali, District Mohali to consider and decide the justice demand notice dated 16.09.2017 (Annexure P-10).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Director General of Police, Intelligence, Punjab, Sector-77, Mohali, District Mohali to consider and decide the justice demand notice dated 16.09.2017

(Annexure P-10) within four weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of four weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible to them or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
