The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Heavy Vehicle Driver in BCB Category. He qualified the written examination as also the Driving Proficiency Test. His documents were duly scrutinized and he was called for interview. However, he was never interviewed by the Commission for being ineligible, since he did not possess three years requisite experience of driving a Heavy Transport Vehicle. Ex facie the petitioner was issued a driving licence to drive PSV Bus on 04.02.2015, and the closing date to furnish the application form was 28.06.2017, thus, he did not have three years driving experience on the appointed date. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that certain candidates, who too did not possess the requisite experience, have since been considered eligible by the Commission and have also been selected.

Notice of motion: limited extent, if any candidate despite not possessing the necessary experience has been considered eligible.

Mr. RK Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

Learned State counsel submits that although the process of selection has been concluded and even the appointments have since been made, but still the claim/grievance of the petitioner, to the extent indicated above, shall be looked into by the respondent-authorities. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
