JASPAL SINGH, J.

Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to grant family pension and GP Fund to the petitioner.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the husband of the petitioner was serving as Constable in Punjab Armed Police with respondent No.2 and died on 04.12.2016 on duty. After the death of her husband, when family pension and GPF Fund were not released, petitioner approached the respondents number of times but till date no action has been taken. Constrained against the inaction of the respondents, petitioner served a legal notice dated 04.12.2017 (P-1) and also moved representation dated 10.01.2018 (P-2), but till date neither any response has been received nor any

decision has been taken thereon. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-2) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commandant, 75th Battalion, Punjab Armed Police, Jalandhar Cantt., Punjab to consider the case of the petitioner unfolded in representation dated 10.01.2018 (P-2) and to decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed, to release the same within next 45 days.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
