In the instant petition, petitioners have prayed for the following relief:

“iv) a writ in the nature of certiorari be issued to quash the action of respondents No.2 to 7 not to inform the respondent No.1 regarding the detail of the candidates who have not accepted the offers; further a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued to respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for selection and appointment as Clerks against the posts remained vacant due to non-joining of the candidates and further direction be issued to consider the claim of the petitioners for appointments from the dates other batch mates recommended on 31.3.2018 and petitioners be granted all consequential benefits;”

2. Petitioner's relief is two fold; one is asking for quashing of the action of respondents No.2 to 7 not to inform respondent No.1. In the absence of document question of quashing the action of respondents No.2 to 7 may not arise. Accordingly, first prayer is hereby dismissed. Second relief is for seeking writ of mandamus. In the absence of appropriate demand

before the competent authority, petitioner has no right to seek writ of

mandamus.

3. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
4. At this stage, learned senior counsel seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition with better particulars.
