For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner prays for a direction to the respondents to consider his claim for promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer and thereafter as Chief Engineer from the date persons junior to him were promoted with all consequential benefits. The petitioner purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P16), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that grievance/claim of the petitioner, as also his representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P16), shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of eight weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

Needless to assert that in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
