This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner the benefit of minimum of regular pay scale for the post of EEG Technician with allowances.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that case of the petitioners is covered by a judgment passed by this Court in CWP-17003-2011 titled as “**Rupinder Kaur and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**” decided on 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-2). Further, he states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director, Research and Medical Education, Sector-69, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 24.11.2017 (Annexure P-3) in view of Annexure P-2.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Research and Medical Education Sector-69, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 24.11.2017 (Annexure P-3) in view of Annexure P-2 within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
