The land of the petitioner as described in para No.2 of the writ petition, measuring 568 square yards, situated within the revenue estate of Mauja Rohtak was acquired by the State of Haryana for the construction of dividing road between Sectors 7-37, Rohtak by HUDA. The acquisition took place in the year 2006-07. The short grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is that her acquired land is still lying unutilized as it was acquired in excess to the actual need for the public purpose. It is stated that dividing road has already been constructed and the petitioner's land is lying unutilized. In this backdrop, the petitioner seeks a direction to declare that the acquisition has lapsed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the observations made in the order of this Court dated 23.01.2014 passed in CWP No.1171 of 2014 (Surjit Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others), the instant writ petition is disposed of in the same terms. Let an appropriate decision be taken by the Competent Authority within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
