1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to take suitable action against respondent No.7 for causing water, air and soil pollution as the aforementioned factory has been set up in the Agricultural land and further direction be issued to respondent No.4 to conduct a proper enquiry with regard to the quality of ground water in the village as due to draining out of the polluted water, the villagers are forced to drink contaminated water whereas odour/colour of water has been changed.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the alternate remedy as may be available to it, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
