The petitioner, a life convict and lodged in District Jail, Kaithal, has prayed for extension of parole, already granted to him, for another period of two weeks to enable him to get his children admitted in the school.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been released on parole on 21.04.2018 and has to surrender back on 02.05.2018.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and examining the available record, I am of the considered opinion that the time granted to the petitioner for the purpose of admission of his children is sufficient, therefore, am not inclined to grant extension in parole to the petitioner for the purpose aforesaid.
