Learned counsel for the appellants and respondent No.4 jointly state that the instant appeal may be disposed of in terms of the order dated 16.05.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Criminal Appeal No.748 of 2018 (Harpreet Walia Sabharwal versus State of Punjab and another), a copy whereof has been handed-over in Court. The order passed by the Apex Court reveals that the appellants and respondent No.4 have amicably settled their dispute and as a result of the compromise, FIRs and complaints under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act have been quashed. Resultantly, the instant appeal has also become infructuous and is

disposed of accordingly except that the appellants, if so permissible under

law, may pursue their remedy qua other reliefs against other respondents,
except respondent No.4 with whom the matter has been settled.

Ordered accordingly.
