The petitioner has again approached this Court for the purpose of seeking the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to construct the metalled road (Pucca Road) bearing Rasta No. 137 in the revenue estate of village Sihma which leads to Village Rampura.

The petitioner had earlier filed CWP No. 20268 of 2017 in which following order was passed on 07.09.2017: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to pursue his representations Annexures P/5 & P/6.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case aforesaid representations have been received in the office of concerned authority, it shall consider the same as per norms.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the representation of the petitioner has not been decided so far.

If that is so, remedy lies with the petitioner is of a Contempt Petition instead of a Civil Writ Petition again on the same cause of action.

With these observations, this petition is hereby disposed of.
