Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. AG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is an ex-serviceman and is currently engaged with respondent No.3 as Junior Engineer. The limited grievance that he has is; that in the past seven years, he has been transferred thirty times. And, thus, he indeed is a victim of multiple transfers. Vide impugned order dated 27.12.2017 (Annexure P3 Colly.) he was transferred from the office of SE/HR, DHBVN, Hisar to office of SE/OP Circle, DHBVN, Narnaul. Although he has challenged his transfer on numerous grounds, but in

compliance to the impugned order, he has since joined at Narnaul, and over a month has gone by. It is urged that the petitioner has repeatedly represented to the respondents as regards the harassment meted out to him. And even prior to his recent transfer, he had represented to the respondents vide representation dated 23.08.2017 (Annexure P6), but to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the grievance of the petitioner, as also his representation dated 23.08.2017 (Annexure P6), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner as also his counsel.

That beings so, this Court is sanguine that the respondent-authorities shall examine the grievance of the petitioner in the right earnest and take necessary/appropriate measures.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.
