This matter is listed before this Court on judicial side to look into the application filed by Pinkey Lalwani and Rekha Kumari daughters of Late Raj Kumar, sisters of Kailash Razdan, who was allegedly confined in Central Jail, Amritsar.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has submitted that Kailash Razdan s/o late Raj Kumar was detained at Wagha Border, Amritsar with fake Indian currency of Rs.22K in the denomination of Rs.500/- rupees currency. She has further submitted that Kailash Razdan was tried for the alleged offence and was convicted and sentenced for a period of one year. It is further submitted that after completion of the sentence, he has already been deported back to Pakistan on 22.2.2018. It is further submitted in response to a query as to how many other prisoners are there in Central Jail, Amritsar. The details have been given as per which there are 29 Pakistani prisoners, 8 from Bangladesh, one from Nepal, one from Myanmar and one from Sierra Leone.

Out of these forty, thirty seven prisoners are male and three are female. It is submitted that since Kailash Razdan has already been sent back to Pakistan, therefore, this petition has become infructuous.

I agree with the submission made by the counsel for the State and hence this petition is hereby disposed of for having been rendered infructuous.
