The appellant had impugned the order dated 21.11.2014, passed by the learned Single Judge, whereby the prayer of the appellant for migration from Panjab University Regional Centre, Ludhiana to University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh was rejected.

The migration was sought in the year 2012. The appellant got admission in B.A. LL.B (5 Year) course for the years 2012-17, which has concluded now. Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the appellant has successfully completed the course.

No doubt, in view of the subsequent developments, the prayer made in the present appeal has been rendered infructuous, however, learned counsel for the appellant sought to raise the issue that during the pendency

of proceedings before the Court at different stages, certain wrong affidavits were filed by the University, for which action deserves to be taken, but still he states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to take appropriate action against the persons, who filed wrong affidavits.

Learned counsel for the respondents does not have any objection to the prayer of the appellant being granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
