1. The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to ensure the land described as Park in the Map (**Annexure P-2**) be utilized only for the purpose for which it was reserved/earmarked in the original site plan i.e. for the purpose of Park instead of fragmenting into the shape of plot near to the High Tension Wire, which would be a violation of the rights of the residents of the area, may after taking the preferential location charges.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Civil Court as certain facts are required to be established by leading evidence.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
