The petitioners pray for a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for stepping-up their pay at par with their juniors, and remove the existing anomaly in the pay scale, with all consequential benefits. The petitioners purport to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the legal notice, dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-6), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, as also their legal notice dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-6), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this

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order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof. And, on the contrary, if the petitioners are found entitled to the relief prayed for, needless to assert that they shall be awarded the consequential benefits.
