The petitioner states that the bifurcation of the Panchayat is contrary to the provisions of law providing a minimum population of 300 whereas in the proposed village the population is considerably less. In this regard he has made a representation which is still pending.

We, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case and noticing the limited prayer made before us, deem it appropriate to direct the respondent No.3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-6) made by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible but preferably before the final decision to bifurcate the Panchayat is taken. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
