Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf the respondents. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner was appointed as an Assistant Professor in the Dental Department in BPS Government Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan, Sonipat. Post four years of service as Assistant Professor, she was re-designated as Associate Professor w.e.f. 19.8.2015, and, thus, she is drawing the pay, allowance and other benefits admissible to the said post. The limited grievance that she has is; that the said post has since been advertised by the respondents, vide corrigendum, dated 15.2.2018 (Annexure P-10). Whereas, as a consequence of her re-designation, the post in question stood filled by promotion. She purports to have repeatedly

represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the representation, dated 31.3.2018 (Annexure P-11), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

As to this, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner, as also her representation, dated 31.3.2018 (Annexure P-11), shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents, within a period of eight weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim/grievance of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
