This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing the Office Order No.129 dated 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-3) qua the petitioner whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Dhariwal Operation Circle, Gurdaspur to District Kapurthala in violation of Policy Instructions dated 11.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) as the petitioner is due to retire on 30.04.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the order dated 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-3), whereby the petitioner had been transferred from Dhariwal Operation Circle, Gurdaspur to District Kapurthala, has not yet been executed. Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is treated as representation and direction is issued to respondent No.2- Deputy Chief Engineer/Personnel, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., Patiala, The Mall, Patiala to consider and

decide the same in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to furnish a copy of the writ petition along with certified copy of the order passed within two weeks from today. Thereafter, respondent No.2- Deputy Chief Engineer/Personnel, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., Patiala, The Mall, Patiala is directed to treat the copy of present writ petition as representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, the competitive authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
