At the first instance, the petitioner may raise his grievance before the competent authority in the Transport Department against his transfer by filing a representation within three days, which will be considered within seven days thereafter. Till such time, status quo will be maintained.

The petitioner will be heard and in case adverse order is to be passed and transfer is to be maintained, then reasons for the transfer must be given to him, which should spell public interest and administrative exigencies.

With these directions, the instant petition stands disposed of.
